


rockymounts™ **Switch**Hitter



Guidelines

This carrier is intended for SQUARE, ROUND, and SLOTTED crossbars (RockyMounts[™]Ouray, Thule[™] AeroBlade, Yakima[™] Whispbar & JetStream, Rhino Rack[™] Vortex, Audi[™], BMW[™], Mini[™], Porsche[™], VW[™], & Volvo[™]). Use on other bars is not covered under our warranty.

Crossbar spread: minimum 16" (41cm), maximum 48" (122cm).

Do not exceed the load capacity of your vehicle's roof rack.

Bicycle weight limit: 35lbs (16kg) factory, 45lbs (20kgs) RockyMounts™, Thule™, Yakima™, & Rhino Rack™ crossbars.

Forks equipped with carbon fiber dropouts or forks without safety tabs are not covered under warranty. Some thru-axles enter from the left and some from the right. Position rack accordingly for easiest access.







Remove Top Cap

Remove top cap from head by lifting up finger




Loosen Strap Loosen M6 bolt with 5mm hex wrench.




Position Rack

Place head onto front crossbar. Slide rear plate



Install Rack

FIRST: Reattach strap around front crossbar, centering head over crossbar. NEXT: Install rear bracket using two M6 bolts and plastic spacers. Tighten M6 bolt with 5mm hex wrench. Tighten two bolts on rear bracket



START HERE: **SLOTTED CROSSBAR MOUNTING** (PART 1)


Remove Top Cap

Remove top cap from head by lifting up finger tab




Remove Bolt

Remove M6 bolt by holding nut in place with flat head screwdriver and loosening M6 bolt with 5mm




3 Remove Strap

Remove steel rod from strap. Use pliers to flatten loops on strap and pull out from bottom of head




4 Install Plastic Spacer

Replace rubber pads with snap-in plastic spacer on bottom of head




5 Install T-Slot Plates

Loosely install two #3 plates through two holes on head using two M6x14 bolts with washers. Use M6x8 bolt with washer to install remaining plate



6 Install Rack on Crossbars

Remove end caps and rubber stripping from crossbars. Simultaneously slide front and rear plates into t-slot in crossbars. Position rack and securely tighten all three bolts




Wheel Strap & Top Cap


Install wheel strap into buckles. Reinstall top cap



Lock Cores (Not Included)

Remove plastic cap on top cap using key. Insert key into core and line up large protruding metal wafer between tabs in housing. Install lock cores








LOADING BIKE


1 Install Axle


Determine bike axle size and install corresponding axle, centering in head, by loosening M5 bolts with 4mm hex wrench. 15x100 axle comes preinstalled. For 9mm QR, install QR into 15x100 axle



3 Secure Rear Wheel & Bike

Feed rear wheel strap through rear wheel into buckle and pull tight. Double check bike is secure by rocking bike back and forth. Fork and wheel should be properly seated and not move






2 Load Bike


Remove front wheel and place bike onto rack with fork dropouts securely seated on axle. Install thru axle or tighten QR and secure bike by closing QR handle (QR should close with tension). If you are unsure, please consult your local dealer or RockyMounts, Inc directly



4 Locking Bike

Pull cable out from rear end cap. Feed cable through rear triangle of bike and lock cable to metal boss








Loosen Strap Loosen M6 bolt with 5mm hex wrench.




Position Rack




Remove Top Cap

Remove top cap from head by lifting up finger tab




Remove Bolt

Remove M6 bolt by holding nut in place with flat head screwdriver and loosening M6 bolt with 5mm




3 Remove Strap

Remove steel rod from strap. Use pliers to flatten loops on strap and pull out from bottom of head




4 Install Plastic Spacer

Replace rubber pads with snap-in plastic spacer on bottom of head




5 Install T-Slot Plates

Remove end caps and rubber stripping from crossbars. Simultaneously slide front and rear plates into t-slot in crossbars. Position rack and securely tighten all three bolts




Wheel Strap & Top Cap



Remove plastic cap on top cap using key. Insert key into core and line up large protruding metal wafer between tabs in housing. Install lock cores






1 Install Axle



3 Secure Rear Wheel & Bike




2 Load Bike


